SUBJECT: Walter Broadhead - Edna Exploration - Stiner Wells, Sec. 24 -  
2N - 3W -- Ute Meridian (Inspection Trip, 10/6/61)

The site of the Walter Broadhead Stiner Well (NENW, Sec. 24) has been leveled; however, the surface casing of the well is about a foot above ground, and within the surface casing is  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " csg. There is no evidence of the well being plugged. The location, however, should not be of any further danger to livestock.

The Edna Exploration well (SENENW, Sec. 24) is capped with a valve set-up which is about 4 feet below the surface. There is no evidence of any fluid or gas escaping. The pits are still open, but dry, and location not leveled. Stiners (landowners) expect new operators to come in to work over the well. They have no complaints concerning this location, and did not write the note to this office (received Mar. 27, 1960).
