Dear Mr. McLaughlin:

I have written to you twice since the first of the year regarding the #3-9 Government, the #5-9 Government and the #29 Patented. The first two wells being located in the NW NW SE, Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 102 West; the second being located in the SW SW, Section 28, Township 2 North, Range 102 West.

On the #3-9, as requested, we need status and plugging record, if the well has been plugged.

On the #5-9 we need an OGCC Form-10 "Producers Certificate of Clearance and Authorization to Transport Oil or Gas from a Lease."

On the #29 we need a Plugging Record.

You have been contacted about these wells several times and since it is my intention to take this matter before our Director, I have reviewed our files further and find the following information needed:

On the #1-34A, Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 103 West -  
A Completion Report.

On the #61 Patented, Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 102 West -  
OGCC Form-10 "Producers Certificate of Clearance."

X We would also like to be advised if the #1-16 Federal, Section 16, Township 1 North, Range 102 West, is still a shut in gas well. ✓

I will expect to hear from you with regard to the above mentioned matters not later than July 1, 1964.
