- Set Ideal cement plug from 2350-2386 T.D.
7" 23# casing from 1600 to 1816'.
Set Ideal cement plug from 1570-1600'
Set Ideal cement plug from 80-100' (bottom of 8 5/8 28# surface casing).
Set Ideal cement plug from surface-4' inside surface casing.
Filled between cement plugs with heavy mud.
Surface casing cutoff 2' below ground level, and no marker erected at the request of the land owner.
