



BRADENHEAD TEST REPORT

- Step 1. Before opening any valves, record all tubing and casing pressures as found.
- Step 2. Collect liquid and gas samples as required; consult Bradenhead Testing and Reporting Instructions and Guidance for field specific Orders at <http://cogcc/reg.html#opguidance>
- Step 3. Conduct Bradenhead test.
- Step 4. Submit Form 17 within 10 days of test. Attach a wellbore diagram if not previously submitted or if wellbore configuration has changed since last wellbore diagram was submitted.
- Step 5. Submit sample analytical results via Form 43.
