We have reviewed the subject proposal forwarded to this office for consideration. We are pleased to find the casing program includes 8 5/8 inch casing set at 924 feet with 650 sacks of cement and 5 1/2 inch casing set at 5410 feet with 100 sacks of cement.

As you are probably aware, the current potable producing formation in this area is the Ogallala formation immediately under the surface of the ground with some potential in the future for Dakota development.

The casing program as stated above, in our opinion, would adequately protect these formations from pollution and we would recommend your approval of the request.
