How was extent determined?			
Five (5) ASTs were removed during partial facility decommissioning activities at the Aspen Abbey State V16-75HN O SA Production Facility location on October 19, 2023, and 5 confirmation soil samples were collected from the former AST locations. The soil samples were submitted for laboratory analysis of the full ECMC Table 915-1 analytical suite, using standard methods appropriate for detecting the target analytes. Preliminary analytical results indicate that the total petroleum hydrocarbon (TPH) and/or polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH) concentrations in soil samples AST-B02@3", AST-B04@3", AST-B06@3", and AST-B10@3" exceeded the ECMC Table 915-1 Protection of Groundwater Soil Screening Level Concentrations. Preliminary analytical results indicate that the remaining constituent concentrations in the soil samples collected during partial facility decommissioning activities were in compliance with the applicable ECMC Table 915-1 standards. Additional analytical results for the soil samples collected on October 19, 2023, are pending laboratory analysis and final reporting. Excavation and site assessment activities are ongoing and will be summarized in a forthcoming quarterly Form 27-Supplemental Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan under Remediation Project No. 31956 (approved Form 27 Document No. 403527131).
