Gentlemen:

Several weeks ago, a "permit to drill" request for a well to be drilled to the Weber was filed with your office giving locations from the records of the previous leaseholder, L. A. Gebauer.

Gulfland Inc., now the assignee of this lease, has had the location surveyed and submitted plat to the Commission which shows the well to be approximately 525' south of the offsetting Lease #C - 028491, held by Pan-American Petroleum Corporation.

It was necessary to make this location because of topographical conditions. Location is on the east rim of a small plateau area. Moving the location south would drop it into the slope of a gulch which drains northeastward into the Coal Mine draw.

For this reason, Gulfland Inc. requests that the Commission grant an exception to the requirements of rule 316 requiring a location distance of 600 feet from any lease line because of topographical conditions and approve the permit which you are holding with our fee check for \$75.

Further to this request, Mr. GeBauer has informed us that his location on the original permit was taken from a plat on file with the U.S.G.S. that shows the location to be 627 feet south of the north line and that he holds an affidavit stating that the corner post had been moved.

We will appreciate your prompt action as we expect that a good Weber well will be made at this location.
