



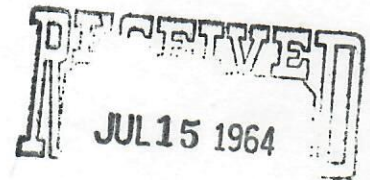

Dear Sir:

I was not aware that we had violated any rules or regulations, as I was told in Rangely by some of the operators that it was not necessary to have a Permit from the State on Government Land. However, on June 10th I wrote a letter to the Oil & Gas Commission stating that Harrison & Smith had completed No. 2 and No. 3 wells and asked for Completion Report forms as I wanted to report them to you. I also asked that you change the Number on the LuBauer 42 well, to Harrison & Smith No. 1. Up to date I have never received a reply to said letter.

I made Application to drill and Permit was granted from the Federal Government, and if you will send me all the necessary form, Application to drill and Completion forms, I will be glad to fill them out.

I am enclosing photo-static copy of the letter written on June 10th.

Hoping this is satisfactory, and will do anything necessary to straighten this out as we certainly do not want to do anything against the Colorado State law.
