Good afternoon, Taylor,

Operators are required to consult with CPW under ECMC Rule 312 for subsequent operations, which includes well repairs and plugging operations.

We are planning repair work on the following well:

- **RWF 431-36**

We have included the identified HPHs associated with this location. We are planning to begin operations upon approval by COGCC and BLM, if required.

As a part of this process, we are required to attach any agreed upon BMPs and correspondence between CPW and the operator documenting consultation. To ensure proper well operations, TEP has proposed the Best Management Practices listed below for implementation during planned activities to minimize potential impacts to wildlife.
