Dear Mr. Skeem,

I am writing this letter is in regard to our telephone conversation today concerning the transferring of your plugging bond (CD #338550) for your Coltharp #C-3, NENW 1-1N-102W which was an abandoned location. The \$5000 plugging bond will be transfered to the W.H. Coltharp A-4, NWSE 35-1N-102W.

It is my understanding that you intend to replace each individual bond currently held by this office by a \$30,000 blanket bond. I have enclosed information that will assist you in getting this bond processed by this office. If you have any problems please contact this office.

After reviewing your well files I was not clear on the current activity on the Coltharp Lease. The map sent to us last August showed the Coltharp #C-2 at approximately 1265 FNL and 1645 FEL. This does not come close to your original footages of 1149 FNL and 2564 FNL, sec 1-1N-102W on your survey plat. Our new field engineer, Brian Macke, will be in the area in the near future and I feel a site visit with an Aurawest representative would help clear up some of the well location discrepancies. Mr. Macke will contact you to arrange a time he may be able to meet.
