DETAILS OF WORK

TD 6404'. Well plugged and abandoned February 12, 1964. Well not economical to produce. Bridge plug set at 5925' with 2 sacks cement on top of plug. Ten sack cement plug set at surface with dry hole marker. All 7" and 9-5/8" casing left in hole. The 9-5/8" casing head abandoned in place. Bull plugs installed in casing head outlets.

Well site cleaned and ready for inspection.
