

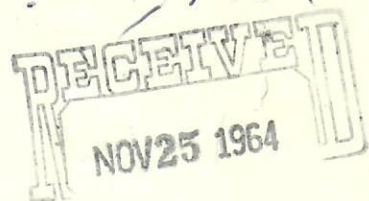

Dear Bill;

In reply to your letter dated Nov. 23, 1964, you have misunderstood my theory as to producing I sand water through D sand perforations. In the period of 14 yrs. while the well was plugged, my theory is that I sand water infiltrated up into the D sand + now I am trying to pump off the I water from the D sand. We did have a good cement job with 125 sacks of cement + have completely cemented off the I sand, thus producing I water from the D section. How much I water has infiltrated into the D sand - no body knows. If the water pumped depletes oil increases over a period of time my theory might be right. If the water increases it probably is D sand formation water. I'm sorry I was not more careful in explaining this. I'll stop in & see you, maybe you can give me an idea. Yours truly
