INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Pursuant to ECMC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the SHABLE USX AB11-16P wellhead cut and cap. The wellhead was cut and capped per ECMC rules. Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. The flowline was previously abandoned on 9/25/2018, and the ECMC was notified on Form 44 Document number 402091030.

Five (5) grab soil samples were collected from the excavation for laboratory analysis. Additionally, soil samples were field screened at the N-E-S-W sides of the wellhead. Soil samples were analyzed by a certified laboratory for the full extent of Table 915-1, including but not limited to: TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per ECMC Table 915-1, EC, SAR, pH, metals, and boron. All samples collected were analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved ECMC laboratory analysis methods.

If groundwater is encountered during the site investigation monitoring wells will be completed and samples will be collected for all organic compounds per ECMC Table 915-1, 1-methylnaphthalene, and inorganic compounds per ECMC Table 915-1.
