

PLUGGING RECORD

INSTRUCTIONS



Within thirty (30) days after the plugging of any well, the owner or operator thereof shall file this form in duplicate for wells on Patented or Federal lands, and in triplicate for wells on State lands, give a detailed account of the manner in which the abandonment or plugging work was carried out, including the nature and quantities of materials used in plugging and the location and extent (by depths) of the plugs of different materials; records of the amount, size and location (by depths) of casings and junk left in the well; and a detailed statement of the volume and weight of mud fluid used.

DETAILS OF WORK

The above described well was drilled to total depth of 5067' KB on 9-23-56. Electric log and drill stem tests revealed no possibility of commercial production from the well and permission to plug was obtained verbally. The well was plugged on 9-25-56 with the below noted procedure.

- Plug No. 1 - From 5045 to 4927' KB with 35 sacks reg. cement
- " " 2 - " 185 to 135' KB " 15 " " "
- " " 3 - From top of surface casing (2' below surface) to 15' below surface with 5 sacks reg. cement.

10# gel mud was placed below and between all plugs.

151' of 8-5/8" OD 36# Casing cemented at 161' KB was abandoned and left in hole when plugged.
