This drainage feature is approximately 392 feet to the east of the well site. The closest perennial water body is Lake Nelson, more than 16 miles from the site. The site is within the extent of the Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) High Priority Habitat (HPH) designated for Connectivity Area and Estimated Occupied Range for the Lesser Prairie Chicken.
