Laboratory analytical indicates a historical release occurred at the Coleman C23-32 decommissioned tank battery. Eight soil samples exceeded ECMC standards for TPH at 522, 667 mg/kg, Benzene at 0.004, 0.003 mg/kg, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene @ 0.008, 0.870, 5.30, 0.039, 0.048, 0.033, 0.059, 0.140 mg/kg, 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene at 0.05, 0.66, 0.01, 0.03, 0.02 mg/kg, Benzo (a) Anthracene @ 0.016 mg/kg, 1-methylnaphthalene at 0.539, 0.505, 0.0278 mg/kg, and 2-methylnaphthalene at 1.1, 0.949, 0.0407 mg/kg. A supplemental form 27 has been submitted detailing the remedial plan, document number: 403652445. The facility lies within Aquatic Native Species Conservation Waters High Priority Habitat.
