<p>Following cut and cap operations at the Lowe 8-12 wellhead on November 27, 2023, confirmation soil samples were collected from the former wellhead and submitted for laboratory analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene (TMB), 1,3,5-TMB, total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH) - gas range organics (GRO: C6-C10), TPH - diesel range organics (DRO: C10-C28) and oil range organics (ORO: C28-C40), pH, specific conductance (EC) and sodium adsorption ration (SAR), boron, PAHs, and Table 915-1 Metals using ECMC-approved methods appropriate for detecting the target analytes. Analytical results received on December 18, 2023, indicate that the TPH, SAR, EC, 1-methylnaphthalene, and lead concentrations in wellhead soil sample WH-B01@8' exceeded the ECMC Table 915-1 Cleanup Concentrations. Additionally, the TPH, SAR, EC, 1-methylnaphthalene, barium and lead concentrations in flowline riser soil sample FL-B01@4' exceeded the ECMC Table 915-1 Cleanup Concentrations. Assessment activities are ongoing and will be summarized in a forthcoming quarterly Form 27-Supplemental Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan under Remediation Project No. 30606 (approved Form 27 Document No. 403440355). A topographic Site Location Map showing the geographic setting of the release is provided as Figure 1. The soil sample locations are illustrated on Figure 2. Soil sample location and field screening data are provided in Table 1. Soil analytical results are summarized in Tables 2 through 5. The laboratory analytical report is provided as Attachment A. Field notes and a photographic log are provided as Attachment B. The State Notification email is provided at Attachment C.</p>
