-BMPs to stabilize the working pad surface and access road are no longer in proper functioning condition; control measures to minimize tracking inadequate; control measures to minimize off-site sediment transport by equipment, such as a vehicle tracking pad, also not observed.

-Erosion degradation observed along slopes on the west end of the Location

Corrective Action: Comply with Rule 1002.f- install or repair required stormwater and erosion control measures in accordance with good engineering practices to minimize erosion, degradation and off-site sediment transport; maintain BMPs in proper functioning condition. Regrading alone at the working pad surface/road will be inadequate.
