KPK is providing the 24-hr notification of a spill from a leak in the consolidated flowline from Facility 8 (Facility 8 @ Pehr 12-1). Xcel Damage Prevention employee (720-445-1588) contacted KPK about the spill on 1.26.24. KPK personnel immediately went to the site, shut in the wellheads, and isolated the flowline. KPK mobilized a vac truck to evacuate the flowline. The Hydro-Vac is removing fluids/stained soil and hauling it to KPK's Fort Lupton yard. The spill is located between the Kerr McGee Pehr Pooling Unit 1 battery and County Road 23. KPK will install a snow fence around the spill. The surface staining was approximately 72 square feet (6'x12').
