INSTRUCTIONS

Within thirty (30) days after the plugging of any well, the owner or operator thereof shall file this form in duplicate for wells on Patented or Federal lands, and in triplicate for wells on State lands, give a detailed account of the manner in which the abandonment or plugging work was carried out, including the nature and quantities of materials used in plugging and the location and extent (by depths) of the plugs of different materials; records of the amount, size and location (by depths) of casing and iron left in the well; and a detailed statement of the volume and weight of mud fluid used.
