## 1. PLAN PURPOSE

Bison IV Operating, LLC (Bison) recognizes the need for developing a responsible water allocation plan as it pertains to Oil and Gas operations. The attached site-specific plan was developed in accordance with ECMC rule 304.c.(18).

## 2. OPERATING REQUIREMENTS

As of January 15, 2021, all new location permits must include a Water Plan. The water plan must identify the planned source of water to be utilized for drilling and completion operations including:

- A. The planned source and volume of all surface water and Groundwater to be used and the coordinates of the planned source of water;
- B. The seller's name and address if water is to be purchased;
- C. If recycled or reused water is anticipated to be used, a description of the source of that water, background concentrations of chemicals listed in Table 437-1, anticipated method of transporting the water, and anticipated volumes to be used in addition to the reuse and recycling plan requirements of Rule 905.a.(3); and
- D. If freshwater is anticipated to be used, a description of why the Operator does not intend to use recycled or reused water.

The operator will maintain a copy of this plan on location throughout the duration of the site drilling and completion operations.

## 3. SITE-SPECIFIC WATER PLAN

Bison's proposed Triggerfish Pad will be located in Township 7 North, Range 62 West, Section 29 in Weld County, CO. The site-specific information detailing the water plan for the Triggerfish Pad is included in Appendix A.
