You can leave the portions located within 5' of and under the existing Kerr McGee and Crestone pipelines that transverse this line. For now we can just abandon in place the North/South portion as we do not anticipate doing work there. In the event in the future it becomes necessary or required by the town, we may require that that north/south portion is then removed. But at this time we do not think that will be the case.

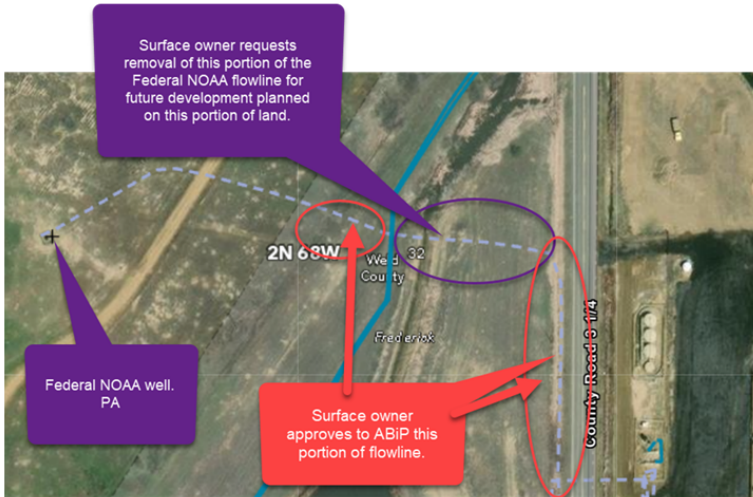

We have some flowlines that travel under CR 3.25 to the recently removed tank battery on Anderson Farms (near the "employee parking lot" on the north end of the farm). We would like to request your approval to abandon the no longer used flowlines in place (of course the lines will be flushed cleaned, confirmed no contamination issues and cut/capped) due to challenges with CR 3.25 and to minimize total surface disturbance on your lands. Below is an aerial detailing the flowlines. Some of them have already been abandoned in place (pre Civitas and Crestone Peak ownership) by Encana.
