The well is located 330 ft. (N) of South and 300 ft. (E) of East line

The elevation above sea level is 4043 ft.

Commenced drilling at 9:00 P.M. on August 15, ¹⁹⁵² 1942. Ran 197.61' of 10 3/4" O.D. 32.75# casing, landed at 208 RBM. Cemented with 130 sacks Ideal Portland Cement and 100# calcium chloride cement to the surface. Let set 48 hours. Tested casing with 400# pressure. Test O.K.
