



Gentlemen:

This is written with reference to the well drilled by you known as the No. 1 Chapel in Section 17, Township 9N, Range 56 West.

We have received the notice that you have abandoned the location and left the well open for a water well.

Before you can be released from plugging this well, you are required to have the person taking over the hole file a letter with us stating that he assumes responsibility of the hole and relieves you of the obligation to plug it.

In order for the landowner to produce water from this well he will have to obtain a permit from the Ground Water Division of the State Engineer's Office, copy to be sent to our office.
