The sidewalls and base of the excavation were resampled for selenium to determine concentration variability due to heterogenous lithology (silty sand) in the collected soil samples. The resampled locations were below ECMC standards for selenium and arsenic excavation confirmation sample concentrations were below site specific background concentrations.
