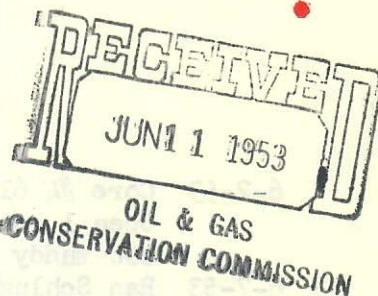

- 5-13-53 Ran and cemented 8 5/8" casing at 611 feet with 275 sacks.
- 5-20-53 Drill Stem Test #1 5289-99 open 2 hours. Weak blow of air, died 15 minutes. Recovered 35' mud, no show oil or gas.
- 5-24-53 Core #1 5754-64 Recovered 10' 5754-56 Sand and shale tight, no show. DST #2 5753-64 Packer failed. Recovered 720' very slight oil cut mud. DST #3 5754-64 open 1 hour. Died in 10 minutes, recovered 45' heavily oil cut wtr. 90' water with slight scum oil.
- 5-26-53 Core #2 5841-51 Recovered 10' sand, none to good, oil stain, scattered to good sample fluorescence, poor to excellent ether cut fluorescence. DST #4 5840-50 Open 1 hour gas in 4 minutes, water 15 minutes. Recovered 5' distillate, 900' water.
- 5-27-53 Core #3 5851-69 Sand and shale, no show.
- 6-1-53 DST #5 5858-69 Open 1 1/2 hours fair Blow gradually diminishing thruout test. Recovered 35' oil cut mud 450' slight oil cut water.
