Gentlemen:

Pending a sale of the equipment used for the production of oil from the above wells I shut the wells down about May 14th, 1975 and they have been shut down ever since. In my report for the month of May, 1975 I reported the sale of all of the oil in the tanks at the time the wells were shut down. On May 16th I entered into a contract for the sale of all of the equipment, the purchaser among other things agreeing to close the wells in accordance with the requirements of the Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission.

I have since then received a check from Mr. Arthur Skaer, paying the balance of the price of the equipment.

In view of the above I should like to be relieved from the bonds covering the above wells executed by the U. S. Fidelity & Guaranty Company, and also the liability policies which I have been carrying with the above company. This would entitle me to receive back the un-earned premiums.
