
The State Commission's positive determination was received by the FERC on April 12, 1979. The FERC's forty-five day review period has passed without remand or reversal and the additional 45 day waiting period has passed. Therefore, Panhandle is releasing the suspended monies due you on Oct. 25, 1979.

Per Section 273.204(c)(3) Panhandle states that no refunds are due from the seller and Panhandle has calculated the amount of suspended monies on the referenced well as \$4,396.39.

Section 273.204(c)(3) of the FERC's regulations requires you to make an appropriate filing with FERC regarding this matter. Please provide the undersigned a copy of your Retroactive Collection filing within 15 days after this retroactive payment is received.
