The Jurisdictional Agency determination was based on information contained in or added to the Application. Review by the professional staff of the Colorado Commission indicates that this well is an (New) (Old) well. The well produces from the "J" Sand reservoir(x); This well qualified as a

stripper well under Filing No. 83-460 . The well produced non-associated natural gas at a rate exceeding 60 Mcf per producing day for the "90 day" period ending Oct. 31, 1983 . Production from the well was 1903 Mcf during the "90 day" period. A petition for "Temporary Pressure Build-up" was subsequently filed showing that the well was temporarily shut-in 82 days.

This conclusion was originated by examination of the contents of the petition.

Which show this well increased daily average production due to temporary pressure build-up when shut in due to pipeline demand and therefore qualifies as a "Temporary Pressure Build-up stripper well under FERC Rule 271.804(e).

Therefore meets the qualifications of a (108) well as defined in the N.G.P.A.
