Five initial grab soil samples were collected for Table 915-1 TPH and organics analysis during the initial assessment. Ten additional soil samples were collected for Table 915-1 TPH, organics, and inorganics analysis during delineation activities. SB-05@0-2' was also analyzed for Table 915-1 metals for waste characterization. A background sample was collected for analysis of SAR, Arsenic, and Chromium (VI).

Two groundwater samples were collected from temporary monitoring wells for analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene, and 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene.

A background sample was collected from native soils off the oil and gas location for analysis of SAR, arsenic, and chromium (VI). Residual metals at the site are in compliance with ECMC Table 915-1 regulatory limits and/or background comparisons.

SOURCE REMOVAL SUMMARY

Describe how source is to be removed.

A limited site assessment was completed to delineate residual historical impacts observed at the site during reclamation activities. Soil samples were collected for Table 915-1 TPH, organics, and inorganics - a waste characterization sample for metals was also collected. Residual SAR and GSSL impacts were observed. Groundwater was encountered, confirming the applicability of Table 915-1 GSSLs - groundwater is in compliance. Source excavation activities will be completed to remove residual SAR and GSSL impacts at the site. Noble proposes confirmation soil sample be collected for ECMC Table 915 TPH, organics, and SAR analysis.

REMEDATION SUMMARY

Describe how remediation of existing impacts to soil and groundwater is to be accomplished (i.e. summarize remedial action plan). Source excavation activities will be completed to remove residual SAR and GSSLs at the site. Confirmation soil samples will be collected to confirm compliance with ECMC Table 915-1 regulatory limits. No further action will be considered when soil concentrations at the site are in compliance.

Excavation activities have been delayed due to limited site accessibility due to wildlife, site saturation, and LO consultation. Excavation activities are tentatively scheduled for the end of 2Q24, but may be delayed further. An updated implementation schedule will be provided in a supp. 27, as needed.
