CFG Energy, Inc. has applied to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("OGCC") for permits to drill two oil and gas wells, the Fosston/State 1-16 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, and the Fosston/State 2-16 in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 63 West, Weld County. Copies of the permits, as sent to the OGCC today, are enclosed herewith. The wells are located some two miles west and slightly north of the intersection of WCR 80 and WCR 69. They are to be drilled on lands owned by the State of Colorado...both surface and minerals, in an A (Agricultural) Zone where drilling is a use by right. Only one well will be drilled right away, but which one will not be known until the geologist completes subsurface mapping with information from the well just drilled to the east, which has changed the geological interpretation.

In order to ensure a rig being available, CFG, starting today, will incur a daily cost of over \$4,500 while waiting for the time period to pass for County comments. The OGCC will waive the seven-day period and expedite the permits if there are no objections to the wells by the county departments that normally review a permit. We are asking that you review the enclosed permits and indicate your concurrence or comments. We will forward these letters to the OGCC to indicate that your department has reviewed the permit applications. Please call me at 351-0733 when you have reviewed the permits in order that I may pick up a signed copy of this letter. Thank you for your cooperation in assisting us with this urgent matter, and please let me know if you have any questions or need more information.
