During well servicing activities at the Hudson 12-26A wellhead, an unknown volume of drilling mud daylighted from the subsurface adjacent to the wellhead. The cause of the release was due to a corrosion hole in the surface casing.

Describe measures taken to prevent the problem(s) from reoccurring:

When surfacing is observed during well servicing activities, all operations are seized. Cementing operations are then conducted to fill in the corrosion hole. The Hudson 12-26A wellhead is being plugged and abandoned and all associated infrastructure will be removed and will not be replaced.
