Four confirmation soil samples shall be collected from the former skim pit/ around the concrete vault and submitted to a NELAP-accredited laboratory for the Table 915-1 analysis. Additionally, three background soil samples will be collected from similar depths and soil horizons as confirmation soil samples and submitted for Table 915-1 analyses. Based on the depth to groundwater indicated by the nearest permitted well, Impetro is requesting the use of residential soil screening levels.

Based on comments in the most recent Form 27-S, the previous operator installed a brown water tank prior to the open pit.
