Day 2: RU casing jacks and pull casing or cut off and pull and lay down casing. Run in hole and set wooden plug and cap with 2 sx sakrete. let set overnight.
Day 3: Fill well to surface with 10-sack grout mix (well mix cement used in Fremont county). Cut casing 4' below ground level. At end of day, weld on steel I.D. Plate.
Day 4: RDSU.
