While working on Remediation Project 29978, it was determined that addition facilities will be abandoned on the Divide Creek Compressor Station location. Multiple buried pipes that are no longer needed will be abandoned per 913.c.(9). No impacts other than the existing remediation project have been encountered to date.

Field screening, photo documentation, and soil sampling program will be conducted in accordance with all 900 series regulations. Samples will be collected from below ground at the base of any risers that will be removed. Soil samples will be submitted for laboratory analysis of full Table 915-1 list of contaminants. Straight sections of below ground piping will be field screened using a PID. Soil samples will also be submitted for lab analysis on any filed screening locations showing PID headspace readings higher than background levels.
