Dear Mr. Smith:

Reference your letter of July 27, 1966.

On March 1, 1966, J. P. Woosley and I, dissolved our partnership which we carried as M W Company, in this division I, own the well in lot 4, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 4, T-1N, Range-102W, and Woosley owns the well on Lot 6.

During the winter we did not pump the well on lot 4 since all it has ever produced is water from a crevice at 1578 ft. the Total depth of this well. I have for the past 30 days started pumping again and it is producing six Bbls. water per day and a slight stain of oil. I have hoped to exhaust the water and hope for a little oil at that time. The well on lot 6, was a dry hole, therefor never produced, and I assumethat Mr. Woosley will plug it.

No. 7 well, I have temporarily abandoned, until I can get around to drilling it deeper. No. 9, was shut down from January till April, and I will get you production reports on this well, as soon as I get the records back up here from home. I wasnt aware they had not been filed

Sorry to have put you to th is trouble, Bill and will be a little more careful in the future. Personal regards,
