The elevation above sea level is 5191 ft.

Cemented on June 23, 1947, 1848 feet of 23#, J-55, 8RT casing and 3829 feet of
20#, J-55, 8RT, casing with 900 sacks of bulk cement. Total of 5677 feet of
7" casing landed at 5688 feet. Temperature survey showed top of cement behind
casing at 3400 feet. Waited on cement 48 hours, tested casing with 800# pressure
for 15 minutes (tested O.K.) then drilled plug.
