Laboratory analytical data indicated a historical release discovered beneath an aboveground storage tank during the Walker AB 12-08 Multi tank battery decommissioning. One soil sample, AST02, exceeded ECMC standards for 1-methylnaphthalene at 0.00795 mg/kg. This location lies within the Pronghorn Winter Concentration High Priority Habitat. The supplemental Form 27 will be submitted for remediation number 35850 detailing the remedial site plan, document number 403912518.

Noble conducts routine AVO inspections of all oil and gas facilities in order to identify and mitigate potential releases. Further, this facility is no longer active and is in the process of being decommissioned. The aboveground storage tank has been taken out of service and there is no longer a possibility of a release originating from this infrastructure.
