Comment:	Weed debris in the form of tumbleweeds were observed unmanaged around the wellhead. Tumbleweeds are a troublesome annual non-native weed that easily breaks off at the stem. Operator failed to control and manage weeds to prevent weed waste and prevent the spread of seeds onto adjacent lands. Comply with Rule 606 to remove weed debris.
