<p>Following facility decommissioning operations at the Fehr 7 8 24 25 26 41-32 Facility location on September 11, 2024, confirmation soil samples were collected from beneath the former aboveground storage tanks (ASTs) and submitted for laboratory analysis of the Full ECMC Table 915-1 Analytical Suite using ECMC-approved methods appropriate for detecting the target analytes. Preliminary analytical results received on September 16, 2024, indicate that arsenic concentrations in soil sample AST-B03@3" exceeded the applicable ECMC Table 915-1 standards and/or background limits. Assessment activities are ongoing and will be summarized in a forthcoming Form 27-Supplemental Site Investigation and Remediation Workplan under Remediation Project No. 36422 (approved Form 27 Document No. 403845162). A topographic Site Location Map showing the geographic setting of the release is provided as Figure 1. The soil sample locations are illustrated on Figure 2. Soil sample location and field screening data are presented in Table 1. Soil analytical results are summarized in Tables 2 through 4. Field notes and a photographic log are provided as Attachment A. The State Notification email is provided as Attachment B. The laboratory analytical reports are attached.</p>
