The Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("the OGCC") has conducted an investigation of the above well site and has made the findings stated in the attached schedule and has found violations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, or violations of required permit conditions, listed in the attached schedule. This notice constitutes a separate notice of violation for each violation listed.

**YOU HAVE 30 DAYS FROM TIME OF SERVICE TO CONTACT THE OGCC TO SCHEDULE A MEETING TO DISCUSS THE ATTACHED VIOLATIONS.**

You must abate each of these violations within the designated abatement time. Where the remedial action requires submission of plans or records, these are to be submitted to the OGCC within the designated time. If you fail to take corrective action within the prescribed time, the Commission may issue a Cease and Desist Order. You are responsible for doing all work in a safe manner in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

1. Informal and Formal Review. You have the legal right to an informal review of this Notice of Violation with the Director and Commission staff. In addition, you have the legal right to a formal review of this Notice of Violation in a public hearing before the Colorado OGCC. You may apply for informal or formal review by submitting a request for review within 20 days of the issuance of this order. The request for review must be submitted to: Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, 1580 Logan Street, Suite 380, Denver, Colorado 80203.

2. Penalties. C.R.S. 1973, 34-60-121(1) provides for imposition of civil penalties of up to \$1,000 for each violation and for each day that such violation continues, unless the penalty for such violation is otherwise specifically provided for and made exclusive of this article. Failure to pay civil penalties may result in denial of permit or other authorizations.

3. Effect on Permit. Following the formal review described in 1. above, the Commission may suspend or revoke your permit or deny the issuance of a permit or any other authorizations. In addition, if it is determined that a pattern of violations exists and that the violations were caused by unwarranted failure to comply, or were willful, your permit may be suspended or revoked.
