Dear Mr. Waggoner:

We received your Notice of Intention to Drill, and Designation of Agent for the proposed test in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 80 West, Grand County, Colorado.

There are several things that are not properly filled out, so I am taking the liberty of returning the entire parcel for correction and re-submission. On the Notice of Intention to Drill, the lease name and well number are designated by you, and if you intend to call the well "Government No. 1", that would be the proper designation there. Coming on down the form, we must have the footage from the section line, and would appreciate having a copy of the surveyor's plat. Under "distance from proposed location to nearest property or lease line," should be the measured distance to the edge of the lease. Under "proposed length of surface casing," "uncertain" will not suffice as we must have sufficient information to determine that the surface water will be protected.

I hope the above will clarify the matters; however, if you have any questions, please contact us. If you are in a bind to start the well, you may contact Mr. A. J. Jersin or Mr. D. V. Rogers for verbal approval.
