It was observed that much of the vegetation species planted were non-native pasture species such as Alfalfa, Orchard grass, and Int. wheatgrass. These species may not be the best adapted to this area or persistent. The abandoned location just north of this location had much more native species that grew much better in comparison. Some of the native species observed were Sand dropseed, Sideoats grama, Indian ricegrass, and Rubber rabbitbrush. It may be beneficial to discuss with landowner altering the seed mixture to include more native species.	CostaR	10/25/2024
