Dear Mr. Kritsas:

On the 24th of February 1958, we approved your intention to drill Well #1 600 feet South of the North line and 1980 feet East of the West line of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 93 West of the 6th P.M., Rio Blanco County, Colorado, on land leased from the First National Bank of Meeker.

Since then, on February 18, 1959, a Mr. C. P. Rigsby of Meeker informed us that subject well was not completed because you had more drilling to do and you expected to make a few more tests. It has now been about a year and a half since we have heard from you about the well, after we have periodically asked you to submit information concerning this well.

For your convenience, we are enclosing three copies of our Form 5, all three copies of which should be completed by you and returned to this office in the event you have drilled and completed this well. Also, we are enclosing two copies of our Form 6, both of which copies should be completed and returned to this office if you have plugged the well.

It is our understanding that you spudded this well May 7, 1958. If you are still in the process of drilling, kindly write to us and explain what your future plans are, and describe how the hole is exposed at the surface.

Also enclosed please find a copy of our Rules and Regulations. These rules guide everyone who drills for oil and gas in the State of Colorado, and they must be complied with. Our records indicate that you have almost completely ignored correspondence from this office. I sincerely urge you to reply to this letter at your earliest convenience.
