A site investigation will be conducted pursuant to COGCC rule 911 at the Prosper Farms 4-65 2-1-6 (443722) oil and gas location pertaining to equipment removal/relocation prior to pad expansion. The (2) current wells will remain active. See site map exhibit for details.

Twenty-two (22) grab confirmation soil samples were collected for analysis by a certified laboratory for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per COGCC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, and boron. Additionally, four (4) grab soil samples were collected for analysis of Table 915-1 metals.

### Proposed Groundwater Sampling

Will groundwater samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, analyses, and locations of samples ):

If groundwater is encountered during excavation activities, a grab sample will be collected for analysis of BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene, 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene, TDS, chlorides, and sulfates.

Source removal is complete. Grab confirmation soil samples were collected for laboratory analysis of Table 915-1 metals, organics, EC, pH, SAR, boron, and TPH C6-36.

A statistical analysis was completed using the Wilcoxon Rank Sum Test for concentrations of arsenic, barium, cadmium, lead, selenium, pH, SAR, and EC. Background and source confirmation concentrations were statistically similar for arsenic, barium, cadmium, lead, selenium, EC, and pH and these concentrations should be considered naturally occurring. SAR is not statistically similar. A site assessment to delineate SAR will be scheduled. The proposed sampling and analysis plan will only include SAR only. Once approved by the ECMC, a site assessment will be scheduled. The anticipated time frame to achieve a no further action will be November 30, 2025.

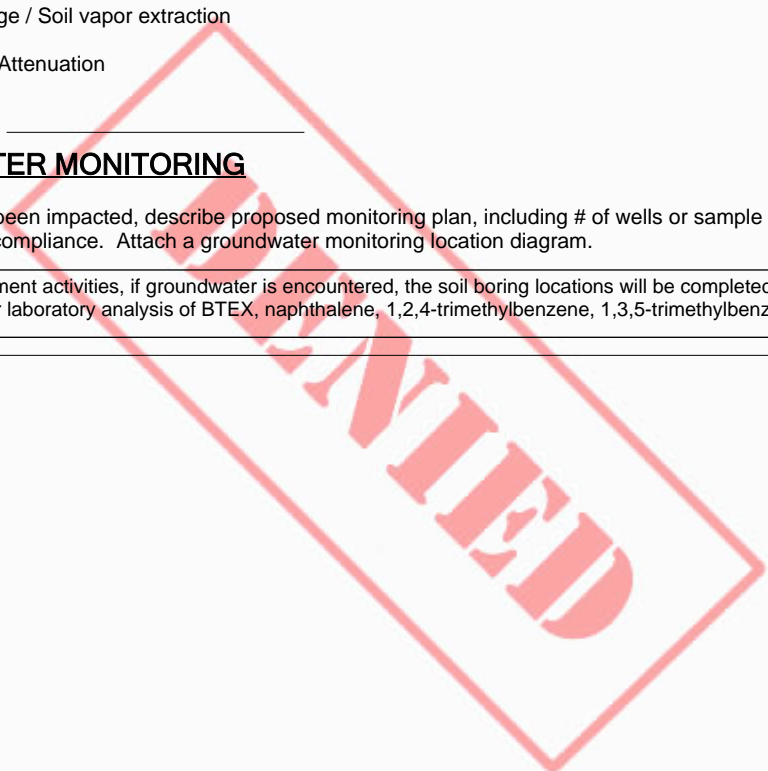

The Civitas Resources insurance program includes Excess Liability coverage of \$110,000,000 per occurrence and in the aggregate which sits over the sudden and accidental pollution within the General Liability coverage. It is the opinion of Civitas Resources that this total tower of limit is adequate to address the costs of remediation associated with any qualifying pollution event.
