To whom it may concern:

PDC Energy, Inc. (“PDC”) is applying to the Colorado Energy & Carbon Management Commission (“ECMC”) to drill wells on the above referenced location. ECMC Rule 408.u. stipulates that no portion of a proposed wellbore’s treated interval shall be located within 150 feet from an existing (producing, shut-in, or temporarily abandoned) or permitted oil and gas wellbore’s treated interval without the signed written consent from the operator of the encroached upon wellbore. As currently planned, the treated interval of the following wells operated by Noble Energy, Inc. (“Noble”) are within 150 feet of the proposed horizontal’s treated interval:
