INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

UGC is plugging the Conoco GOVT 35 #801 well. UGC environmentalist will collect soil samples from the surface under all production equipment and where the flowlines are cut and capped. Surface equipment for this location includes: well head (sample taken at 4ft depth), meter (sample taken at 1ft depth), separator (sample taken at 1ft depth), tank (sample taken at 1ft depth), and historic pit (sample taken at 5ft depth). Samples will be collected from where the flowlines associated with this well are cut and capped. All samples collected from the working surface will be analyzed for constituents under Table 915. Three background samples will also be collected as apart of initial site investigation. Background samples will be used for reference to samples collected on the working surface. Any surface equipment samples in exceedance with Table 915 will be reported to the ECMC via Form 19/Form 27, and will be excavated further to delineate the extent of impact.
