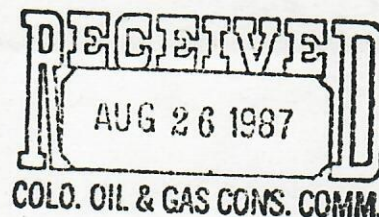


Approval to Subsurface Commingle
Twelve Amoco Operated Wells
Weld County, Colorado

In reviewing our files, we have been unable to locate approval from the Commission for the attached application dated November 4, 1985. Of the twelve wells listed in the application, three wells, the Foreman Unit 4, Rocky Mountain Fuel /C/11, and Rocky Mountain Fuel /C/12, have to date been commingled in the Sussex, Shannon, Codell, and Niobrara zones.

Amoco is interested in commingling some of the remaining wells listed on the attached application as well as a number of other wells currently producing from the Codell-Niobrara zones. Our review of the three wells currently commingled in the four (4) zones indicates essentially no differences in production performance versus dual completions; yet the cost to complete, service, and repair offers considerable savings versus the dual completions. However, before we submit an application to commingle additional wells, we want to confirm approval for the application dated November 4, 1985, was granted and is still valid.


