Although we have some concern with the differential downhole initial pressure for the various formations based on your explanation regarding crossflow and damage, with which we agree, the commingling is approved provided protests are not received from offset operators within the time allowed by Rule 322. We concur that the economic benefits of full commingling will enhance recoveries through additional drilling and extending the economic limit of producing wells.
