Lexi,

**Timing:** Once we receive approval to plug and abandon this well, we anticipate that we will spend approximately 4 days with a workover rig on site. We will work daylight hours.

After the rig releases, we will return to the location to cut the casing off below ground level and cap it. That process should take 1 day.

**Work Description:** I don't have a formal document for the plugging procedure, but I have attached the proposed plugging plan from the ECMC.

Day 1 - Move in Rig Up Workover Rig, Pull Tubing out of Hole

Day 2 - Move in Rig Up Wireline Unit, Run Cast Iron Bridge Plug and Dump Bail Cement. Shoot perforations at 2,500'. Move in Rig up Cement Unit - Pump Cement for Plug at 2,500'.

Day 3 - Shoot perforations at 900', pump cement for plug at 900. Shoot perforations at 288', pump cement for plug at 288'.

Day 4 - Top of Casing with Cement, Rig Down Move Off Workover Rig

**BMP:** We anticipate only working during daylight hours, there will be no lights used during the plugging operation.

In regards to noise, we will provide written documentation from the landowners within 2,000' if they agree to our operational noise. If we are not able to acquire written documentation from landowners we will setup temporary sound walls during the workover operations.

We will not work on this well in the period from November 15th through March 15th.

The wellsite will be returned to crop land after we cut and cap.

I assume you won't be able to provide me approval until I have the noise documents in hand, but thought maybe this would be a good start on communication?
